

INFINITE WISDOM broke alertly and established control, cut over to the inside, was coaxed along setting the splits, closely attended by the second place finisher parked out in path two, was let out for the drive, drifted out towards the two path at the head of the stretch, steadily extended the margin. SEEKING ALPHA stalked the winner from the two path, held on well enough late to preserve the place. RED GUARD was allowed to drop back during the initial stages, underwent a ground-saving journey, rallied willingly but fell short of snagging away second. TALE OF FANCY raced three wide on both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. LIAM'S PRINCE unhurried in the early going, graduially made its way into the four path during the initial stages of the run around the far turn, responded when let out a notch at the five-sixteenths marker, unleashing a solid run from that station, spun one path wider into the stretch, mustered up a mild response in the late going to mainly improve position. BLACK EAGLE travelled three wide on each bend, had no rally. UPTOWN JOE saved ground to midstretch, made no impact after being angled outward. CONTRADICT reserved in the two path, came three wide into the stretch, had no offering.
