BAYOU BANKER set the pace early, was on the inside into the far turn, remained clear in the stretch under a steady drive. SILVERTOWN chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. CITE was unhurried early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. DIPLOMA was well placed early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and improved position. OTTO'S DREAM stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty late. AESOP was through after a half. AMERICAN CORREDOR was never involved. FARMERS CHOICE was bothered entering the lane. COLONEL JACK was done early and eased in the stretch.
