DUVAL ST. pressed the pace early, took over command, was on the inside into the far turn then drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. PAT'S SHOES stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and was no match for the winner in the stretch run. PROUD MAXX was unhurried early, fanned into the five path in the far turn with a belated gain in the stretch drive. RUNMALIBURUN was well placed early, shifted into the four path in the

far turn and moved up in the stretch. I'MBETTERTHANGOOD fanned into the five path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch. MUDDBONE ROAD dueled early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded late. INSPIRE COURAGE was hammered by foe early on. SCOUT LEADER was hammered by foe early and squeezed back. SELF STARTER tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was empty late. SUCCESSFUL PLAN was never involved. POINT AFTER veered in sharply while out of control and crashed into multiple foes early on. GALLANT STEED was bumped hard and bothered early.
