

DOUBLEBOLT pulled way up to the lead in late backstretch, took over in hand, widened advantage on top and kept clear under steady urging. TREASURE rated ening quarter then picked up pace running around far turn, came under ride three to four wide, was no match for clear leader in lane but continued steady bid for place. RING KNOCKER was taken back and settled in back of the pack, launched four wide bid entering the head of lane and produced solid finish. ALPINE SKY was allowed to settle in early stages, hustled up two to three wide in the turn, split foes midstretch and improved. INDIAN GODDESS raced up close and chased pace two off inside, angled to rail entering the head of lane and finished evenly. FREEDOM'S TRIAL came under ride in far turn, shifted out four wide and failed to move on. JANE'S CAT rushed up to take lead at start, continued on top then lost lead to eventual winner in opening quarter, continued just off rival in far turn, could not keep up pace at furlong marker and weakened.
