DAY OF FURY broke out a step bumping lightly with PICOZZA, attended the pace from the two path through the first turn settling in hand latched on to EVER RIDER into the backstretch, took over command narrowly from that foe with nine-sixteenths to go, came under a light coaxing midway on the turn, shook away through the latter portion nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, extended his margin a bit to the furlong grounds, dug in under a drive under growing tepid late threat and held safe drifting out in the shadow of the wire to score. LIEUTENANT SEANY O just off the pace two to three wide tracking the front, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to cut into the winner's margin late on while procuring the place honors over a closing rival. MILLS just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, took to the rail seven-sixteenths out, came under a ride three furlongs from home, spun three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick closing in tandem with the aforementioned foe on the eventual winner and secure the show honors. PICOZZA bumped at the start by DAY OF FURY who broke out a step, chased just off the pace three to four wide under urging from the three-eighths, angled five wide for home and offered up a mild bid for the last major share. STRONG STIPULATION chased three to four wide from near the rear, got put to encouragement three furlongs out, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and improved position in the drive. STARRY MOON chased the pace along the inside under a ride from midway on the turn far turn, swung just off

the inside into upper stretch, gained ground through the drive wheel unable to improve position through the final eighth. LUCKY LOTTO three wide through the first turn, settled three to four wide in mid pack, got put to urging midway on the far turn, angled six to seven wide for home, offered no response. CELEBRATED TALENT stumbled badly falling to his face at the start and conceded six to seven lengths to the front once able to regain his footing and momentum, settled two to three wide at the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung just off the inside for home and was unable to make an impact. IRSAAL forwardly placed just off the inside through the first turn, raced three wide in range of the front down the backstretch, got shaken off midway on the turn by the eventual winner as did the rest of the field and came under urging five-sixteenths out in response, angled four wide at the quarter pole, tired in the stretch. EVER RIDER (ARG) in hand on the pace early on under the watchful eye of DAY OF FURY to the outside, got displaced with nine-sixteenths to go and came under light coaxing, faded after a half giving chase pushed along three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and faltered.
