PURSUING FATE was reserved just off the leaders early, moved three-wide through the turn, reached DOUBLEBOLT with a sixteenth to run and proved best over that rival in the final yards. DOUBLEBOLT was bumped at the start, dueled for the while racing three-wide with TAR AND FEATHER, disposed of that rival before going a half, quickly opened a clear lead but could not resist the winner late. DIAMOND EARRING settled off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. RING KOCKER lacked early speed, raced three-wide through the turn, angled in nearing the eighth pole and finished with late interest. RACEN was forwardly placed early, moved three-wide through the turn and lacked the needed late response. YA ESTA lacked early foot, raced three-wide through the turn and was not a factor. GENTLE HUMOR was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not offer a bid. TAR AND FEATHER disputed the pace from the inside with DOUBLEBOLT and weakened after going a half.
