ASPEN HILLTOP off a beat slow, raced three wide at the tail of the field detached from the main body, got asked and angled five wide seven-sixteenths from home, advanced outside through the bend and swung seven wide into upper stretch, sustained a rally through the stretch to issue a challenge inside the final sixteenth, surged outside late and got up in the final jumps to score. BERNED four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong out, dug in and took command a sixteenth out fully extended, got collared and denied the victory in the final strides to the wire while clear of the rest for the place honors. JAMYSON 'N GINGER broke in at the start, chased just off the inside until tucked inside through the turn, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, swung just off the inside into upper stretch between foes rallying to seize command with three-sixteenths to go, dug in under threat from a pair and yielded a sixteenth out, then weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. TORRENT brushed the near side stall at the start, chased five then four wide just off the pace under a ride from the three-eighths, spun four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive fighting on to the sixteenth marker before weakening in the late going. THIRTYDAYSINJUNE broke inwards awkwardly hitting the near side stall at the start briefly askew, chased just off the inside near the rear early on before tipping three wide through the bend coming under a ride with three furlongs to run, continued three wide at the quarter pole, offered no response. BEMUS POINT six wide early on down the backstretch, tucked to chase four wide through the turn urged along from the midway point, continued four wide for home and made no impact. MORE THAN TREASURE coaxed from the gate, prompted the pace four then three wide through the turn coming under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and folded. RECOLLECTION hustled from the gate, cut a swift pace three then two wide under pressure from the aforementioned foe to the outside, came under a drive five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch the innermost of a quintet stacked across the track, yielded the front three-sixteenths from home and faltered in the drive.
