ROYAL COPY bobbled slightly at the break yet broke on top despite it, prompted the pace maker from the three path in hand until placed to urging five-sixteenths from home, continued three wide into upper stretch, took command briefly nearing the eighth pole before being headed at that station and bumped lightly by PREETY BOY FLASH, dug in knocking heads trading another light bump a sixteenth from home before inching away late on kept to task. PRETTY BOY FLASH stumbled at the start, raced four wide in range of the front stacked outside the top pair, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to poke a head in front under an off sided stick and came in slightly bumping the aforementioned foe a furlong from home, tussled head to head and got bumped himself a sixteenth out before being shaken off late on while clear of the rest for the place honors. LOOKIN AT BLESSING bobbled slightly under coaxing from the gate, cut the pace under some pressure from a pair to the outside, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home under threat from a pair, dug in headed nearing the eighth pole, weakened in the late stages to the finish while safe for the show honors. CONFEDERATE two to three wide at the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, began to angle out from the five-sixteenths to swing six wide into upper stretch, improved position for the last major share while making no headway on the front. LEVIATHAN tracked the pace along the inside under prolonged coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, cut the corner into upper stretch, came up empty. ARCH OF THE DIVER away well, was taken in hand and eased back from the two path to be taken outside to chased three to four wide shortly after the start, came under prolonged coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide at the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.
