GENERAL DOWNS bumped with the breaker next door in the shadow of the starting gate, moved up into a forward position, stalked a pair of foes from the three path to the five-sixteenths marker, had the middle one, that benign T R CREW drop back a bit as the three-quarters was being reached, scooted by and got guided into path two, arrived at the head of the stretch in a practical dead heat with SINGLETON, the more confidently-handled of the two, was put to a drive after being allowed to get settled in, inched away, but without shaking free, saw T R CREW muster up a burst of speed a sixteenth later, turned back both that rival and the second place finisher in game fashion. TALE OF MIST was bumped at the start, settled into the two path on the homestretch, had the rider take hold as BUTLER FIELD was shifting into his two path on the first turn, went on to cut the corner into the backstretch, was on the move to the outside coming to its end, got maneuvered into being four wide from the top of the second bend to the five-fifteenths pole, turned for home under a drive, charged towards the winner, hitching up in the general area of the sixteenth pole, vied with vigor to the end but was denied. T R CREW remained towards the inside after leaving the starting gate, got checked while in close proximity to the heels of SINGLETON as that opponent was being worked onto the inside route early on the clubhouse turn, tipped into the two path and went on to stalk the aforementioned foe, began to fall back as the third fraction was being recorded, resulting in the pilot asking the mount for a little more, but with no positive result coming from it, was under a full drive swinging three wide into the stretch, proceeded along it from between rivals, put together a good turn of foot altering course closer to the inside with approximately a sixteenth remaining, continued to chisel away at the deficit but had to settle for the show award. SINGLETON broke on top and kept the advantage, cut over to the rail nearing the top of the first turn, crossing over in front of T R CREW before successfully along the rail and leading its pilot to check, had that foe take up the role of primary pursuer, undertaking the task from the two path, edged away but gained no respite, with the top one issuing a challenge of his own soon afterwards, was let out approaching the quarter pole, remained prominently placed for a furlong after yielding, then tired. MAGICIAN MAN sat pocketed to the quarter pole, was put to urging angling two wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. BUTLER FIELD three wide stepping onto the opening bend, was in the two path leaving it, kept watch on the front front runners from between rivals to the five-sixteenth marker, was sent over to the rail just as MAGICIAN MAN was vacating the premises, had no rally. ROUSTABOUT bumped from both sides at the break, raced four to three wide on the first turn, travelled in the three path on the next one, folded.
