HEAVEN IS WAITING came away alertly, raced side by side with the second place finisher seemingly from the get-go, rated as was the rival to his inside, get let out for the drive home, vied with vigor down the lane and gamely got the job done. SOGLIO remained along the inside after a clean getaway, was coaxed along racing as a team with the top one, continued under the same conditions until it was time for the stretch run, was given its cue for that, dug in with determination throughout but was ultimately denied the top prize. HUMO D'ORO settled into the two path once out of the starting gate, was pulling a bit on the bit during the initial stages, but otherwise sat reserved in a professional manner, raced from between rivals beginning late on the backstretch, got given his cue spinning into the lane, angled to be outside the top twosome, came home with good energy en route for the show. PROFITEER took up position in the pocket, was coaxed keeping watch on the front runners, got steadied approaching the quarter pole as HUMO D'ORO was being called upon at that juncture, held his ground well under a light drive during the ensuing furlong, mustered up a much more appealing display of acceleration when put to a more energetic ride in the final eighth. DREAM TRIP saved ground for most of the opening six furlongs, got asked for a response being taken to the outside at the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals past the eighth pole and flattened out. RISKY TOWN swung three wide into the backstretch and would remain as wide stepping onto the second bend, got sent to path five during the initial portion of the stretch, made no impact. ARCH OF THE DIVER strung out three wide on the far turn, gave way.
