Footnotes

GENERAL DOWNS raced in the three path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, went around most of the far turn in the two path, was roused while moving to the three path outside the quarter-pole, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead before the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong handling. TOUGH CUSTOMER went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer in the four path on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, gained into upper stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker under a drive, battled into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while just able to get the place. PRODUCER was last away then urged along early, went four then five wide on the first turn, rushed to the lead with five furlongs to run, controlled the action in the two path on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under the whip just after turning into the stretch, fought on well into the final sixteenth but was out-kicked then just missed the place. SOUTHSIDE WARRIOR went four wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came under the whip in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. CHICORY BLUE was rank while towards the inside through the first turn, tugged at the bit under a strong hold early on the backstretch then was rated off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch in the two path, had the rider lose his whip at the three-sixteenths, saw the rider peel off his goggles outside the furlong marker, struck the horse with the goggles on the right side, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. SOCIAL MISFIT set the pace on the inside, lost the lead at the five-eighths pole, was asked while inside on the far turn, chased into upper stretch then weakened. MY MAN COLTON saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten.
