ARROGATE hustled from the gate to secure the inside position to be well placed, stalked the pace along the backstretch, guided out three wide into the turn to go after the leaders, poked a head in front with five-sixteenths to go, drove clear nearing the quarter pole while under a drive, remained under intermittent pressure to the sixteenth and was geared down confidently to win the inaugural Pegasus World Cup Invitational. SHAMAN GHOST was allowed to settle through the opening stages going three to four wide into the first turn, moved closer inside and began finding stride two wide on the far turn, came three wide rallying into the lane, lugged in going by NEOLITHIC and jumping back to his left lead a sixteenth out and finished with good energy to clearly best the others. NEOLITHIC forced the pace outside NOBLE BIRD two wide around the first turn and down the backstretch, took a short-lived lead still in the two-path between calls on the far turn, could not keep pace with the winner a quarter-mile out and was overtaken for second in deep stretch. KEEN ICE was outrun for six furlongs three wide, found his best stride four wide into the stretch and finished willingly while never a serious threat. WAR STORY saved ground around the first turn, was well placed in the clear off the first flight down the backstretch, continued on rail thereafter and finished evenly while losing ground to the leaders. NOBLE BIRD broke to the lead despite a slight bobble at the start and moved to the rail around the first turn, came under pressure from NEOLITHIC and ARROGATE approaching the far turn and began to weaken after six furlongs. SEMPER FORTIS raced two wide early while outrun, improved position slightly two to three wide into the far turn and continued on evenly while well back. BREAKING LUCKY was four wide around the first turn and briefly within range of the leaders, dropped back along the backstretch, went three wide around the far turn and could not make up ground. CALIFORNIA CHROME was strung out five wide heading into the clubhouse turn, raced within easy striking range outside the leaders down the backstretch, was put to hard pressure four wide approaching the far turn, had no response and began dropping back steadily after six furlongs. PRAYER FOR RELIEF saved ground early while far back, and was unable to reach contention two wide into the far turn. WAR ENVOY lost footing the start and bobbed, was righted and then saved ground around both turns and dropped far back approaching the stretch while two wide. ERAGON (ARG) trailed from the outset, was eased in the stretch and walked off.
