REASON TO SOAR broke near the back and raced wide leaving the backstretch, roused past the quarter pole, set sights on MR VARGAS top stretch, ran down rival in the final furlong and quickly pulled away. MR VARGAS dueled in opening stages then took over the lead, continued clear along the inside in upper stretch but was no match for REASON TO SOAR in the final furlong. EXCLUSIVE PACKAGE steadily advanced closer racing along the inside, slipped through along in the turn, angled out few paths and continued steady bid. NORTHERN hustled up from the outside, angled out wider three furlongs out, advanced position then evened out late. THAT CHARLIE dueled for the early lead with MR VARGAS, could not move on with rival but continued in range then lacked a needed kick in reserve. ENTANGLED drifted in and caused a chain reaction of bumping at the start, raced in contention then failed to sustain bid and lost ground. GOLDEN KANTHAROS got bumped at the start then quickly moved up into contention, continued with good response three furlongs out then failed to sustain bid and faded into the lane. DOPO LAVORO raced off the early pace, angled closer inside at the head of the lane then moved back out and failed to rally. TIMEISEVERYTHING got bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide into the lane and failed to move into range. TRIO OF CHAMPIONS got slammed into at the start, raced off the pace and failed to kick on. EL CHAVAL trailed throughout. KATY'S COOPER got bumped sideways at the start and showed little. SMART DUDE got bumped at the start, showed early response then dropped far back. JOURNEY'S END rushed up in to duel for the early lead, could not keep up the pace and dropped far back after the half.
