Weights: Thursday, March 23. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The New Orleans Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary fee if applicable. HONORABLE DUTY raced in the two path on the first turn, was unhurried well off the pace, saved ground while urged along on the far turn, came into the stretch in the two path, angled out inside the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up in the final stride. BREAKING LUCKY raced in the two path on the first turn, disputed the fast pace on the inside of a rival, vied in the two path on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, shook clear under the whip into upper stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied on the wire while well clear for the place. IRON FIST bumped with a rival at the start, raced in the three path on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the far turn, lost touch with BREAKING LUCKY into the stretch and weakened while safely securing the show. EAGLE moved in early, went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. HAWAAKOM bumped with an opponent at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to threaten. NOBLE BIRD went around the first turn in the three path, settled in fourth position, was asked while in the three path on the far turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and came up empty. MO TOM bumped with a rival at the start, rounded the first turn in the two path, lingered well back in the field, moved out then came under urging at the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the far turn and was no factor. INTERNATIONAL STAR bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and never reached contention. AGLIMPSEOFGABBY went around the first turn in the four path, tracked the leading duo for five furlongs then stopped and was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
