Footnotes

I STILL MISS YOU out-broke the field and retained the advantage, cut over to the rail, led the way, being pressured by a pair of opponent parked out in paths two and three respectively, had that three way tussle morph into a one on one contest with the WAKI PATRIOT by the five-sixteenths pole, got roused coming into the stretch, with the previously-named foe following suit a couple of jumps later, shook free down the stretch, crossing the wire having been kept to the task at hand. BEST PERFORMANCE chased the pace four wide on the turn, was slightly wider getting set down for the drive home, failed to dent into the margin once past the eighth pole but won the place. WAKI PATRIOT angled in sharply springing from the gate, brushed with CONTRARITY a few times in rapid succession and wound up securing the three path by the half mile pole, vied as the widest of a threesome from that station to the five-sixteenths pole, duelled with the winner the rest of the way to the head of the stretch, got held off, altered course over to the rail in deep stretch, lost out on second. SUGAR QUEEN pressed the issue from the two path in between rivals to the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. DI MARIA lunged at the break in an awkward manner, appearing to scrape the side of the starting gate, was hard used for most of the way on the backstretch, departed it towards the two path, pursued the front runners, still asked, but not as vigorously as before, swung six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ONE LAST CAST underwent a ground-saving journey, went about on the turn lightly hand urged, stepped into the stretch and came up empty. CONTRARITY lost her footing as the field was sent on its way, proceeded along in the three path during the initial stages, traded a few brushes with WAKI PATRIOT as they headed for the conclusion of the backstretch, lost interest and fell back slightly, travelled two wide on the turn, got placed four wide at the head of the stretch and made no impact. ZODACIOUS taken in hand momentarily after the start, worked up a quick tuck into the two path, remained stationed there taking up the chase during the run around the bend, made it into the stretch and failed to have a rally when asked.
