SHARP ART was well placed early, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch and edged clear in the final stages. DISCREETNESS set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. THIRSTFORLIFE chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. GENERAL DOWNS was unhurried early, angled off the rail in the turn and moved up in the stretch. TOASTING MASTER bobbled at the start, stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and weakened late. BAD STUDENT tracked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and faded down the lane.
