ZIGMUND came away alertly, pressed the issue from the two path, was lightly hand urged during the run around the bend, drew abreast of the runner up as the half was being completed, was asked for more as a tussle between them began, led by a slim margin by the furlong marker, steadily extended the advantage, ridden out. BROCKMONINOFF inward with its initial step, went shoulder to shoulder with its next door neighbor for the next two strides, settled along the inside, vied with the winner, put up resistance before relinquishing, then reached the wire in time to salvage second, although still moving well. CAUSFORCELEBRATION shied out early on the backstretch and away from BLESSED HOINOUR, itself shying away from SIM CARD, proceeded along in

the five path heading to the conclusion of the backstretch, found room and worked out a tuck into path three a few jumps beyond the half mile pole, picked up interest, still rated though, as the half was being completed, was put to a ride angling four wide into the stretch, finished with a flourish, but missed out second. DIAMOND SETTER in the two path stepping onto the turn, altered course into path four from upper to midstretch and closed in well enough to earn the final significant slice of the pot. LUTHERAN RAGS got leaned upon by the winner for the first two jumps, departed the backstretch from the two path, got swung four wide into upper stretch and rallied mildly. LAKE PARTY saved ground on the turn, angled three wide for the stretch run and made no impact. SIM CARD within range in the two path on the turn, had no rally. BLESSED HONOUR shied from another early on the backstretch, pursued the top twosome from the three path and tired. HEROISM two wide at the top of the turn, failed to menace. GOOD OLD BOY rode the rail, cut the corner under a drive and came up empty. FRITTER off a half length the slowest, stepped onto the turn from the two path, never reached a contending position. SCOOPSIE PATATO sent over quickly to the rail, was through after going a half.
