Footnotes

BARBAROSSA four wide down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, advanced under mostly his own power through the turn into contention when roused four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, went clear under a drive to prevail. TEN EYCK five wide down the backstretch, chased three wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung five wide for home, proved no match for the top one while along for the place honors besting the rest. NATIONAL HONOR just off the inside near the rear, got coaxed along three furlongs from home, went four to five wide into upper stretch, improved position to secure the show honors. CHASINDAMONEY showed the way in hand under brief prompting inside from JUST BUSTIN and then pressure from ROCKIN JO from midway on the turn, got set down spinning just off the inside for home shaking away briefly, got overhauled nearing the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. CAUSFORCELEBRATION four wide down the backstretch, chased just off the inside through the turn under a ride from the three-eighths, cornered four wide for home, passed tired foes. ROCKIN JO four then three wide in aim, advanced to press the leader from the midway point on the turn coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch and tired. NOLINSKI bumped at the start by SIR FROST, chased inside from mid pack under coaxing from the three-eighths, spun just off the inside for home and offered no rally. JUST BUSTIN showed speed prompting the leader along his inside for half put to coaxing with three furlongs to go before backing away,

cutting the corner into upper stretch and ultimately folding in the drive. SIM CARD four then three wide in pursuit, got pushed along midway on the turn, went three wide for home and made no impact. SIR FROST broke in at the start bumping NOLINSKI, chased just off the inside from mid pack under a ride from the three-eighths, cut the corner for home and tired. BADABOOM showed brief speed five then four wide, retreated through the turn, continued four wide for home and faltered. HEROISM chased three then two wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, went three wide at the quarter pole and was outrun.
