Footnotes

CANDY ZIP departed the backstretch from the three path under a hand ride, was driven into path five for entrance into the stretch, closed in well, wrested away the lead with approximately a sixteenth remaining and edged away. DIG THAT MINE two to three wide, cointended for command in the middle of foes from the half mile pole to the sixteenth marker, held a narrow and short-lived with under a furlong to go, held on reasonably after being displaced by the winner to secure second. FLASH DRIVE gained the lead soon after the start, cut over to the inside, was forced to fend off a pair of foes to the outside on the turn, was still battling them spinning into the stretch, yielded leaving the furlong marker, had enough left to nail down third. SMOKIN PLATINUM raced three to four wide, put up a fight for the front as the innermost of three from the top of the bend until approximately a sixteenth to go before weakening. DANNY CALIFORNIA came away a half length the tardiest, took the two path on the turn, altered course twice during the stretch run, winding up seven wide late, seemed to make some belated headway. VIOLENT DELIGHTS saved ground for nearly a half, came three wide into the lane, lugged in at the three-sixteenths pole, inched its way towards the middle of the course afterwards, altered to the inside in deep stretch and flashed late foot. LUTHERAN RAGS broke open the gate, chased the front runners from the near the inside, was urged angling out at the five-sixteenths marker, lacked the necessary stretch response. MY MR. WONDERFUL chased the ongoing pace dispute from the two path and tired. DIAMOND SETTER three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting it, fought the rider travelling through the furlong grounds. SHOOK EM UP strung out four to five wide on the turn, was never in it. FOOLISH GHOST chased a trio of front runners contending for the lead during the run around the bend and faltered.
