GOOD GUY BAD GUY chased off the rail then angled in on the hill, came out a bit into the stretch and again nearing midstretch, rallied under urging to the front in deep stretch and proved best. ESKIMO ROSES sped to the early lead, kicked clear and set the pace off the rail, drifted out a bit crossing the dirt, continued off the inside, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. KNIGHT DISRUPTOR settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, angled in crossing the dirt, came out some in the stretch and bested the others. ROCKAWAY (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside on the hill and into the stretch, split rivals late and lacked the needed rally. LIBERAL LUNACY stalked three deep then off the rail leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. FENGARI settled just off the rail then inside on the hill, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. DANNY O also settled off the inside chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. NAVAJO DREAMER (IRE) stalked between horses then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. BARTLETT HALL chased outside then alongside a rival, drifted inward in midstretch and did not rally. CAPTAIN N. BARRON close up stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the hill, drifted out three deep into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
