Footnotes

GOLD SHIELD saved ground near the rear, took to the two path down the backstretch, tipped out four wide nearing the midway point on the far turn and bid into contention taking over command at the head of the stretch, drew clear under a drive kept to task. SMOOTH DADDY coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside through sensible splits under attendance but little pressure from ROMAN APPROVAL to the outside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths under challenge for the initial time, got headed and swung three wide for home, proved no match for the top one, weakened late while holding for the place honors. ST. LOUIE two to three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung five wide into upper stretch, kept on for the show honors. SCHOLAR ATHLETE tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, went four wide into upper stretch, weakened. ROMAN APPROVAL broke out at the start, attended the pace from the two path coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. ACCOUNTABLE saved ground at the rear of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
