SAINTS' GIRL was rated while tugging at the bit on the inside, drafted along the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, moved out behind the leader at the three-sixteenths, accelerated with a huge stride, was given one crack of a left-handed whip coming to the furlong marker, took the lead inside that marker and drew away under a moderate hand ride to prove much the best. D' CAT broke very alertly, set the pace through sensible fractions, controlled the action along the rail on the turn, was asked in upper stretch, lost the advantage inside the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. METER was bumped at the start and forced into another rival, raced just off the pace under restraint, drafted in the two path on the turn, shifted to the four path outside the quarter-pole, spun five wide into the stretch and weakened. ANDTHEBANDPLAYEDON pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the two path on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch, drifted in near the furlong marker and tired. FLYING ROSIE was bumped at the start then bobbed slightly, settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while inside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, was put to the whip before the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. DADDY BOAT broke in and bumped with a rival, moved up while in hand, was let out in the three path on the turn, floated into the four path entering the stretch and came up empty.
