Footnotes

FLAMBOYANT (FR) was unhurried to the half, saved ground while waiting for room to the quarter pole, rallied when clear into the stretch, pushed up to take the lead leaving mid stretch and held under strong urging. EDITORE (BRZ) never far back to the half, was two wide to the stretch then shifted out and closed willingly but too late. MANY ROSES contested the pace from the rail to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch, stayed on to deep stretch then was outfinished. SYNTAX (IRE) raced unhurried to the half, had to swing out six wide on the second turn then closed steadily to the line. CAMINO DEL PARAISO was in traffic to the first turn and in check, settled on the backstretch, got fanned five wide to the stretch and was gaining ground to the line. FRANK CONVERSATION stalked the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the late stages. GRECIAN FIRE was settled to the half, tried to rally three wide to the stretch and could not threaten late. MR. ROARY was four wide to the backstretch, rallied up two while engaging for the lead, dueled to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. BIRD IS THE WORD lagged to the second turn, was fanned five wide to the stretch and lacked a closing response. AQUA FRIO stalked the pace in the early stages, got outrun on the second turn and weakened. FULL OF LUCK (CHI) had no speed, raced four wide to the stretch then gave way. NO MORE TALK chased the pace for five furlongs then gave out.
