A Supplementary Nomination of \$30,000 each may be made at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$5,000 to enter and an additional \$5,000 to start, with \$1,000,000 guaranteed, of which \$600,000 to the owner of the winner plus 100 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$200,000 to second plus 40 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$100,000 to third plus 20 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$50,000 to fourth plus 10 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$30,000 to fifth and \$20,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Toyota Blue Grass will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 151 nominations.

GOOD MAGIC came out at the start, was well placed early on along the five path, shifted into the four path entering the lane while making a bid, swiftly took command in the stretch while driven clear and held sway at the wire. FLAMEAWAY vied for the lead early on while off the rail, took over command along the backstretch, shifted into the three path entering the lane and yielded late in the stretch run. SPORTING CHANCE stalked the pace early while off the rail, fanned into the five path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch, was lugging in near the eighth pole, ducked out sharply near the sixteenth pole and weakened late in the drive. FREE DROP BILLY raced back early on from the five path, swung into the six path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but was bothered badly and altered near the sixteenth pole and flattened out late in the drive. BLENDED CITIZEN was unhurried early on, swung into the six path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch, steadied a bit and altered in near the sixteenth pole with a mild gain in the final stages. KANTHAKA chased the pace early along the four path, fanned into the five path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch run. TIZ MISCHIEF trailed the field early on along the five path, altered to off the rail entering the lane with some gain in the stretch drive. MARCONI was back early on from the five path, shifted into the three path in the far turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. ZING ZANG broke a bit slowly at the start and raced back early from the three path, stayed in the three path entering the lane and improved position in the stretch. CALIFORNIA NIGHT was through after a half. GOTTA GO came out at the start and was done early. MACHISMO came out at the start, was bumped into the first turn, fanned into the seven path in the far turn while making a bid but was tired down the lane. DETERMINANT was bumped going into the first turn, swung into the six path in the far turn. ARAWAK had early speed then folded up. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY, ALSO THE RIDER OF FREE DROP BILLY CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF SPORTING CHANCE FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE SIXTEENTH POLE, AFTER REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS, SPORTING CHANCE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR THE INFRACTION.
