MR. TWINERY was on the pace from the outset, raced two wide to the stretch then outbattled MIDNIGHT MING to the line. MIDNIGHT MING The latter was outside the winner contesting the pace, came three wide to the stretch then continued to respond but could not get by. AWESOME ANYWHERE chased the top two three wide to the stretch then was gaining in the late stages. SUNDAY NAP was hustled along to stalk the leaders to the turn, came two wide to the stretch then was outkicked in upper stretch and weakened. TWICE AS FAST chased the pace three wide to the stretch then had little to offer in the drive. CANDY'S MARTINI had no speed, trailed to the turn then saved ground but was not a threat. PULPITS POWER was also outrun to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch but lacked a closing bid. SAGITTARI was never a threat. PASHITO chased to the turn but saved ground and gave way.
