**Footnotes**

HOKULEA four then three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung seven wide into upper stretch, rallied into contention when bumped by JOE'S SMOKIN GUN a furlong out due to pressure from GRAND VALOUR who came outwards nearing that station, closed well to get up in the final jumps over a trio to his inside. CAUSFORCELEBRATION just off the pace just off the inside, tucked inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, took over command straightened away, inched away to the eighth pole, dug in

under threat from a trio and was caught in the final jumps to the wire. BEACH ACCESS just off the inside in mid pack, tucked inside through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung three to four wide for home, drifted out near the eighth pole filling the space left by GRAND VALOUR who came outwards, dug in and fought on between foes through the final sixteenth to secure the show honors on the line. GRAND VALOUR three then two wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive in prominence and came out nearing the eighth pole bumping and leaning on JOE'S SMOKIN GUN squeezing that rival out and forcing him to steady between foes against HOKULEA, then battled on between rivals to the finish and was outfinished in the late going. DESERT LIGHTS coaxed from the gate, settled just off the inside in pursuit from near the rear, rode the rail through the turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. JOE'S SMOKIN GUN coaxed from the start, raced three wide in aim of the leader coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch, rallied between foes when bumped and leaned on by GRAND VALOUR and was forced to steady out being pushed into HOKULEA at the eighth pole, couldn't recover to the finish having lost most of his momentum. CANTAKEITANYMORE chased three then two wide from mid pack coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide at the head of the stretch, offered no response. CROSS MULTIPLY chased five then four wide under encouragement from midway on the turn, went six to seven wide for home, offered no response. MR. SKITTLES six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled out seven to eight wide offering up a mild bid into upper stretch, couldn't sustain the brief move and made no impact. SHARP BID five wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three to four wide for home and made no impact. NUCKS established the front from the get go and showed the way early on until confronted inside by BRILLIANT SCHEME conceded the front five and a half furlongs from home and prompted that rival from the two path under coaxing with three-eighths to go, swung five wide into upper stretch, tired in the drive. BRILLIANT SCHEME away from the start in mid pack, came under coaxing to be rushed up inside to take over command five and a half furlongs from home, got prompted on the lead by the aforementioned foe to the outside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside for home under threat from a host, succumbed the front straightened away into upper stretch and faltered. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on BEACH ACCESS at the eighth pole as well as a Claim of foul by the rider of JOE'S SMOKIN GUN alleging interference against GRAND VALOUR and HOKULEA. After review, the objection against HOKULEA was dismissed as well as the inquiry into BEACH ACCESS at the eighth pole. GRAND VALOUR was disqualified from fourth and placed sixth having been deemed to have interfered with JOE'S SMOKIN GUN at the eighth pole before the race was declared official.
