REASON TO SOAR followed along patiently behind the leading trio around the turn, was guided out widest with three-sixteenths to go, and was up on the far outside in the closing yards. FRONT LOADED pressed the pace outside SMALL FORTUNE early, challenged between horses through a long drive and fought on gamely to just miss. BARRY KARAFIN BETS was never far back, launched a bid three wide turning for home, and kept on gamely between horses to the finish. SMALL FORTUNE broke in bumping THANKS GOD at the start, sped to the front slightly off the rail up the backstretch, faced three challengers through the lane and yielded stubbornly late inside. TWENTY AND FOUR raced three to four wide and faded around the turn. QUINIENTOS hopped at the start and was off behind the field, went two wide on the turn and was never in the hunt. THE BEST CANDY dropped back three wide after a half-mile. THANKS GOD was bumped by SMALL FORTUNE at the start, and dropped far back after going a half.
