REASON TO SOAR broke out at the start then tracked then tracked the early pace, sat on hold under confident patient handler, made move top stretch, went to move in but lacked room, back out then slipped between to battle for late lead, gained slim edge in deep stretch and held firm approaching the wire. CAUTIOUS GIANT was rated in range through the backstretch, raced between rivals going by three eighths pole then took closer order racing three to four wide leaving the turn, set down four wide top stretch, dueled gamely for late lead, got edged out in final strides. HARRYHEE cleared out of the gate and angled near inside, raced under pressure from SPLASH RULES then dueled with rival mid-way through the turn, cut the corner and dug in gamely holding narrow lead, battled back with strong effort dueling in late drive then lacked closing kick. SPLASH RULES prompted the early pace then edged up to duel outside of HARRYHEE past three eighths pole, continued to duel til eighth pole then failed to keep up the pace, gaweway. SWEETONTHELADIES slightly bobble and came away step slow at the start, saved ground racing in or near the back then shifted outside and raced wide lacking needed rally. QUIJOTE got brushed step after the start, raced in the last flight then wide upper stretch to no avail. THREE RULES briefly raced up close along the rail then edged back and shifted outside, raced in second flight leaving the backstretch then failed to sustain bid past three eighths pole, retreated.
