CATHOLIC BOY put to a firm hold by the pilot after an apparent clean getaway, grabbed the advantage as the first fraction was being finalized, carved out the pace, well rated in path two, with ANALYZE IT in attendance in path three, likewise well reserved, continued along under the same set up all the way down the backstretch and nearly all the way on the far turn too, saw the runner up drew on near even terms approaching the quarter pole, settled into upper and was turned loose, lost round one of their stretch duel, beginning the final furlong trailing by about a long neck, battled onward showing no quit, coming back on with good heart to re-claim the front from a very determined opponent in the last forty yards. ANALYZE IT away forwardly placed, sat reserved accompanying CATHOLIC BOY in path three, crept up to increase his presence during the final stages of the run around the second bend, spun into the lane, trailing by about a long neck, responded when called upon, vying with vigour to become the new leader by the eighth pole, continued onward with gameness, saw the winner chop away at the deficit sliver by sliver, was caught in the shadow of the finish line and wound up having to settle for the second

best designation. HUNTING HORN (IRE) pursued the two twosome in between opponents from path two, swung four wide into the lane, finished willingness to secure the show, even while lugging in at intervals during his stretch run. CHANNEL CAT unsettled and in a bit tight heading off the homestretch, got checked, moved to the outside, travelled three wide on the turn two, came under a ride angling six to seven wide into upper stretch, closed in, although without making any impact. KINGSTAR (FR) reserved two wide for three-quarters, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. MARAUD strung out three wide, lacked the needed response. HAWKISH underwent a three wide journey for six furlongs, spun into the lane and had no rally. MY BOY JACK quickly tucked into the two path, stepped into the stretch in hand and would remain in hand the rest of the way to the finish line. ENCUMBERED pocketed keeping an eye on the lead, was put to a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, faltered.
