MOSES SUPPOSES was reserved pressing the isuse from path two, crept up as the half was being completed to draw on near even terms with the leader, shadowed that opponent by swinging wider, stepping onto the head of the stretch, was given his cue and issued its bid, stationed in path three, out-fought a stubborn rival to emege at the eighth pole as the new leader, felt the second place finisher's presence in the final stages but was kept going well enough to stay in the clear. FERRAD'S PARTY appeared unsettled between rivals for a period of the journey along the backstretch, settled down and took up the chase in two path during the run around the bend, got angled into path five from upper to midstretch, finished with good energy, but fell short. CASA RAE

came in springing from the starting gate, crowding and carrying inward the threesome who broke directly to the left, made it over to the rail soon afterwards with the advantage, pulling a bit on the bit, carved out the pace, attended by the winner in path two, wandered almost onto the inside border of path three when called upon for more heading home, relinquished after putting up a fight, by the furlong marker, then weakened into the show slot. CAUSFORCELEBRATION forwardly placed three wide, lacked a solid closing punch. NO WORRIES MATE reserved two wide for the opening half, failed to make any headway in the last eighth. RIDOLFO forced towards the inside due to pressure coming from CASA RAE in the shadow of the starting gate, got set up in the pocket, kept watch on the front runners from there to the end of the bend, got moved into path four after stepping past the quarter pole, had no rally. WON'T BE MISSED pushed in the direction of the rail due to pressure originated by CASA RAE after the field had been sent on its way, saved ground, shifted into path six during the stretch run, made no impact. CROSS MULTIPLY two wide in pursuit of the front runners on the bend, had no stretch response. BLUE SKIES FOREVER squeezed after being crowded a short distance out of the gate, took the inside route on the turn, was under some encouragement spinning into path two entering the stretch, had no gain. STRAITOUTA CONGTIN got checked after lunging badly at the start, rode the rail for the opening half, got worked into path four from upper to midstretch, never made its presence felt. SOUP BABY two wide and placed under a light hand ride on the turn, launched no bids. STEP TO THE BANK rank and getting out on the turn, was out of the picture by the quarter pole.
