J J'S DREAMING was hustled to the lead, rounded the first turn in the two path, was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the tempo in the three path on the far turn, was roused while extending the advantage near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch then was put to a right-handed whip, drew off under a drive into the final sixteenth then was put to a hand ride while much the best. SPEKE broke out and hit the gate solidly then bumped with a rival, went around the first turn in the four path, tracked the winner on the outside under coaxing, came under stronger encouragement around the half-mile pole, chased the winner under the whip in the four path on the far turn, floated six wide into the stretch and weakened but earned the place. KERRY BOY went around the first turn in the five path, settled on the outside, was urged along in the four path on the far turn, dropped to the three path under a drive into the stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. DANNY CALIFORNIA was bumped at the start while off a step slow, went two to three wide under restraint on the first turn, settled down the backstretch, was urged along in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and faltered. FULLBACK FOYE went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, fell well behind, saved ground under urging on the far turn and showed little.
