Footnotes

ESKIMO KISSES sluggish after springing from the gate, was content to bring up the rear, travelling about the two path one-paced, sprang to life approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, was let out a notch and scurried into contention with a bold two wide run, came under more vigorous handling by the five-sixteenths pole and maintained the momentum, swung into the lane, temporarily putting COACH ROCKS in tight while beating that opponent for position, took off in earnest after the one to catch, wore down that rival by the start of the final furlong, kicked away, cleared over to the inside with a sixteenth remaining and extended the margin, kept to the task at hand. SHE'S A JULIE forwardly placed to the inside of TALK VEUVE TO ME, took hold and tipped to the outside as the aforementioned foe was getting set up towards path two early on the first turn, accompanied that one three wide afterwards all the way to the top of the second bend, shifted closer to the rail once the pacesetter did, stayed within striking distance, was put to a drive issuing a challenge entering the stretch, back into path three, ground her way to the place in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT BISOU off the inside throughout, spun three wide onto the backstretch, was just as wide leaving it, came under a drive commencing the stretch slightly wider, mustered up a response sufficient enough to grab the show. TALK VEUVE TO ME out-broke the others and retained the advantage, established control in hand and cut over into the path two shorting after entering the clubhouse bend, got rated along showing the way, at times briefly venturing a bit wider off the rail, got guided over to the rail leaving the half mile pole, came under heavy pressure approaching the top of the lane and was given her cue, put up a fight before relinquishing, then weakened late. COACH ROCKS seemingly played followed the leader, moving about so as to loosely draft behind the pacesetter, was down along the inside route when put to a drive a short distance from the quarter pole, steadied when in tight prior to cutting the corner into the lane, lacked the needed response. PIEDI BIANCHI faltered off a ground-saving journey. AUSPICIOUS BABE made it onto the inside well before arriving at the end of the homestretch, abandoned it coming up to the half mile pole, was put to a ride angling into path three at the three-eighths pole, stepped into the lane and had

no offering. FIGARELLA'S QUEEN took up the chase three wide to the midway point of turn two, turned into the stretch appearing to have little left, was placed to a protective hold then eased the length of the stretch, crossed the wire for the final minor slice of the pot then made it off the track without need of outside assistance.
