Footnotes

SOMELIKEITHOTBROWN bobbled at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, rallied five wide on the far turn, closed strongly to get the lead outside the quarter-pole then quickly kicked clear under a left-handed whip, switched to his proper lead outside the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip just inside that marker, widened under the whip into the final sixteenth then was placed under a brisk hand ride while much the best. DOUPS POINT rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, advanced on the far turn while moving from the three path to the six path, hesitated while trying to give relief to horses in tight quarters to his inside coming to the quarter-pole and secured the place while no match for the winner. EARLY RETIREMENT went around the first turn in the two to three path, dragged his way forward late on that bend to contest the pace on the outside, drew off in tandem with THE GLOMINATOR to open a sizable advantage, shortened stride in the two path on the far turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired but held the show. IMPAZIBLE ODDS saved ground on the first turn, was urged along while outside on the backstretch, advanced while moving from the two path to the four path on the far turn, swerved some in traffic around the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch then leaned in some and weakened. DASHING DAN broke in the air and was off very slow, spotted the front of the field at least six lengths, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, advanced while moving from the two to the five path on the far turn, steadied off heels at the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch then drifted out, ducked out near the furlong marker and had nothing left. CRAZY LIFE raced inside early on the first turn then moved to the two path, was

urged along on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the far turn, leaned in some just after turning into the stretch and capitulated. PIER FORTY went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to the two path, jumped marks on the track outside the five-eighths pole, was urged along well off the pace, advanced two to three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and faltered. THE GLOMINATOR was asked leaving the gate, moved in while going to the front, contested the pace on the inside, drew off in tandem with EARLY RETIREMENT to open a sizable advantage, shortened stride along the rail on the far turn and stopped. TAPTAPTAP was taken in hand early then became very rank while wrestled back against the rail, continued under very vigorous restraint then moved out into the first turn, raced in the three to four path while still rank on that bend, dropped back under urging early on the backstretch, advanced in the two then three path on the far turn, came up empty into the stretch and also faltered. (Rail at 18 Feet) TIMES WERE ADJUSTED FROM THE INCORRECT TIMES ON THE VIDEO DUE TO A FAULT IN THE TIMER BUT WERE COLLECTED ELECTRONICALLY
