BENEVOLENT PRINCE saved ground controlling the issue, was roused into the final furlong then not pressured late when clearly best. THE CONSTABLE was forwardly placed along the inside rail and just lasted for second. EL SOLDADOR was caught in tight along the rail early then was rank into the first turn, closed outside in the stretch and just missed for second. MISTER OBVIOUS responded well in the drive to close on the second flight. RECLINER moved up wide into the stretch and finished best of the others. CLASSY NEKIA got out into the first turn then lacked a rally. LAMBOURN raced between horses in the second flight then tired. BEL GIORNO was carried wide on the first turn then was no factor. SURVOYANT tired. IRISH COLONY was carried wide into the first turn then was no factor. PURRS AGAIN tired from his early effort.
