**Footnotes**

SEEKING THE SUNSET bobbed slightly at the break, recovered and pulled his way forward, was keen to go saving ground just off the pace, steadied briefly near the five eighths, eased out for room after six furlongs, went after the leader with a quarter to go, wore that one down and went clear a furlong out then widened under vigorous left handed encouragement. BENEVOLENT PRINCE cleared early, set the pace under a light hold and towards the rail, was confronted entering the lane, dueled past the three sixteenths, ceded a bit later but continued willingly to be well clear of the rest. MR. BRIDGER dropped well off the early pace while saving ground, came under pressure around the final turn, eased out in upper stretch and only had a mild kick. THANK YOU RICKETTS , off the pace while about four wide near the half, swung further out past the three sixteenths and showed late life. GREAT BEND settled well back while saving ground, came off the inside near the three sixteenths but lacked a solid kick. RULE YOURSELF , between runners leaving the far turn, angled in to make a mild run past the sixteenth marker then flattened out. BLOWIN SMOKE chased the pace while outside a rival and faded nearing the

lane. ACCOLADE stalked outside was under a solid ride past the five sixteenths, failed to kick on in upper stretch and weakened. SADLER BAY failed to menace. SUGAR TRAIN was outrun. AMPLIFY saved ground in range of the leader, was under a hard ride leaving the far turn, sustained a catastrophic injury near the three sixteenths and was euthanized. There was a stewards' inquiry but no action was taken
