BROCKMONINOFF pressed the pace two to three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, took over inside that station, swung three wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive kept to task. WILD WILLIAM tracked the pace from in range just off the inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. CAUSFORCELEBRATION four wide in pursuit from mid pack, tucked to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, came under a ride at the three-eighths, swung

four wide for home and kept on for the show honors. BACK OF THE WATCH lost his rear footing when splaying at the start, chased three wide from just off the pace under coaxing from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. GOOD OLD BOY broke in a step and was bumped solidly at the start by ENCHANTED FOREST breaking outwards and conceded four lengths to the front, chased just off the inside from the rear of the field, tucked inside with seven-sixteenths remaining, swung three then two wide straightened away for home and passed tired foes. ENCHANTED FOREST broke out at the start bumping the aforementioned foe solidly at the start, chased just off the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing tucked inside seven-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole, then flattened out in the late stages. CROSS MULTIPLY just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside seven-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung six to seven wide into upper stretch and offered no response. NO WORRIES MATE three wide in pursuit from near the rear, got coaxed along at the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, tipped out to the center of the course nearing the eighth pole and made no impact. PEQUENO GRANDE brushed the off side stall at the start getting away slow and conceding four lengths to the front, chased four to five wide under encouragement from three furlongs out, swung four wide for home and made no impact. THE MASON FACTOR just off the pace four to five wide, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. QUINTARELLI hustled from the gate, cut the pace under pressure from BROCKMONINOFF three then two wide put to coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, had the rider apply a firm near sided hold appearing to want to get out through the turn, got headed inside the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and tired.
