DOMINANT STRATEGY away without apparent mishap, was towards path two eyeing the runaway leader from afar, picked up interest as the half was being completed, cruised up, drawing up directly abreast a furlong later, took over and edged away, still under confident handling, was put to a drive spinning into the stretch, left the eighth pole in possession of his largest advantage, held on well enough long enough to preserve the decision. **KULIN ROCK** two to three wide on the clubhouse bend, was more in path two taking up the chase on the subsequent one, was put a ride by the five-sixteenths marker, narrowed in during the first half of the stretch run, altered course to be outside the winner in midstretch, kicked into his best, missed. **GOSILENTLY** strung out three wide on both turns, swung slightly wider into the stretch, made no headway in the final furlong. **CONSCRIPTED** loped along at the back of

the pack taking the inside route, got fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, displayed strong late energy down the center of the course en route for the last major check. JO'S BOLD CAT rode the rail for the initial half and a little more, was put to some urging getting tipped to outside early on the second bend, got angled four wide into the lane, lacked the needed response. HONEY DONT sat reserved in path two, drafted behind the winner turning into the stretch, came up empty when called upon. DANNY CALIFORNIA moved over to the inside after the break, continued to save ground tracking the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, had no rally. THERE GOES BEN off the inside, travelled three wide on the second bend, failed to make his presence felt. LOOKING READY off the quickest, remained along the rail, spurted off from the competition, was confronted by the top one leaving the half mile pole, relinquished and faltered.
