JUST RIGHT exploded like a rocket from the gate, set the pace under pressure from his outside, was coaxed in the two path on the turn then asked for more at the five-sixteenths, kicked clear into upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip inside the three-sixteenths, drew off into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip and was given one crack at the sixteenth-pole then placed under a strong hand ride to the wire while much the best. RED ZINGER broke out at the start, was rated just off the pace, saved ground under coaxing on the turn, came under a left-handed whip while in pursuit of the winner in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. WOODBURY broke a half-step behind the body of the field as they left the gate in three flights, raced just off the pace on the outside, was asked in the four path on the turn, spun five wide into the stretch then came under a left-handed whip and weakened but held the show. PIER FORTY broke alertly and was one of two to leave the gate in the first flight, pressed the winner on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn, turned into the stretch under a left-handed whip then dropped back past the three-sixteenths and tired. BRET'S LEGACY settled off the pace, was roused while two then three wide on the turn, spun six wide into the stretch under one crack of a left-handed whip, dropped back while switched to a right-handed whip around the three-sixteenths and faltered. GREG KING OF KOOL was unsettled in the gate and unprepared for the start, broke slow and spotted the front a bit over three lengths, settled at the rear, dropped well behind in the two path early on the turn and was eased but walked off.
